Subject: Two Rivers Residents - Landfill Opposition Committee (TRR-LOC) - Updated information

Attached is a brief outline to help prepare you for the Anne Arundel County Public Hearing on National Waste Managers' (**NWM**) proposed Chesapeake Rubble Landfill. If this rubble landfill is approved, because it is to be immediately adjacent to Two Rivers (see maps attached), it will affect the quality of your and your family's life and the value of your property.

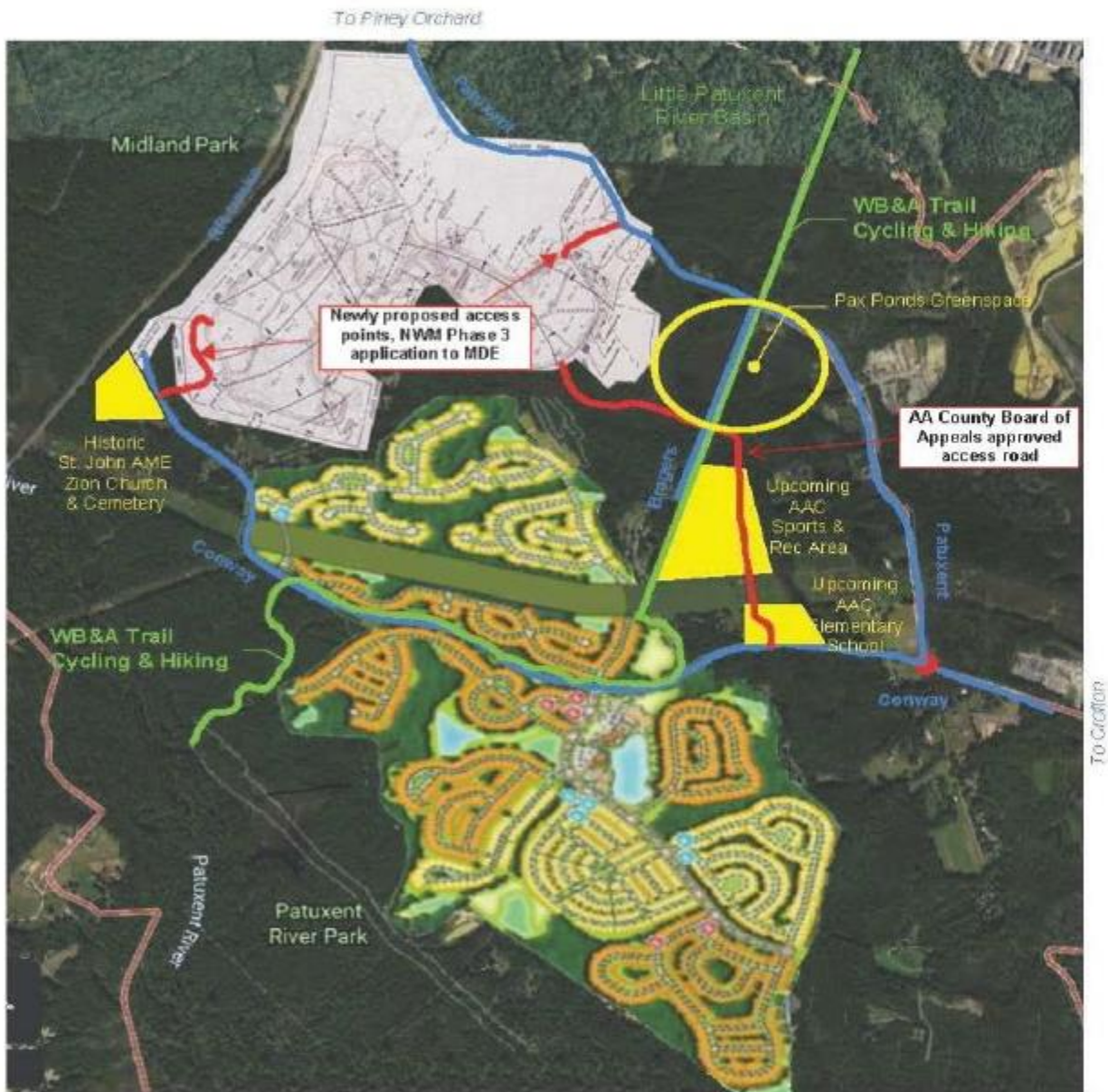
The purpose of the hearing is for the Anne Arundel County Board of Appeals to consider the impact of NWM's request for a time extension for the development the landfill, on:

- the character of the neighborhood,
- the appropriate use or development of adjacent property, and
- the public welfare

The attached outline is a general overview of issues related to the proposed landfill. It should be easy to understand, and is based on information that has been developed by the Two Rivers Residents - Landfill Opposition Committee (**TRR-LOC**).
